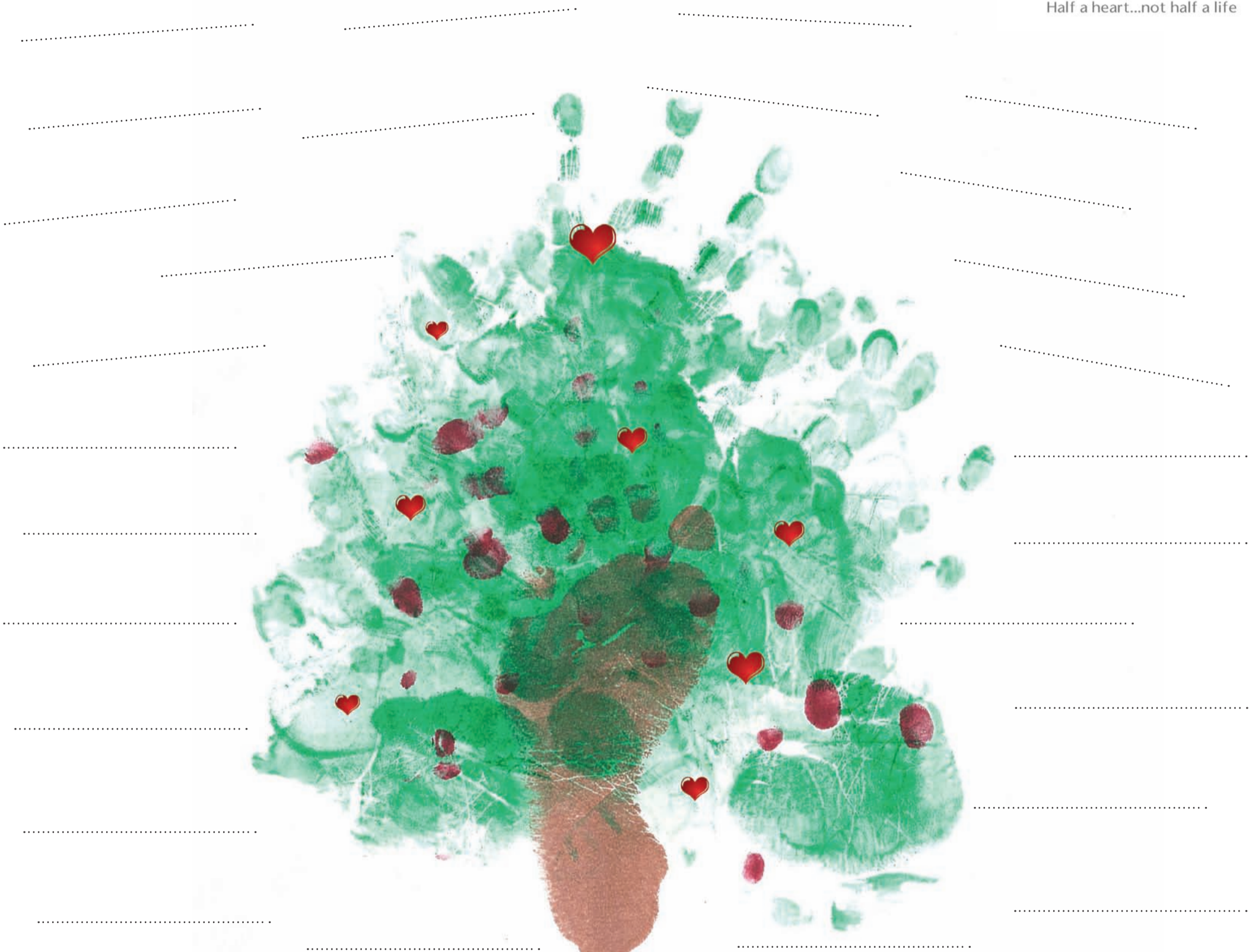


Big Hearted Christmas Card

Around 600 children are diagnosed with having half a heart every year in the UK. Twenty years ago most of these children would have died within a few days of being born, but today there is life-saving surgery available for most of these children, although their hearts will never function normally and many of them will need a heart transplant in their early adulthood. Sadly some still do not survive.

Isolation and fear are part of daily living for these families. At Little Hearts Matter we offer the glue that holds shattered lives together, giving information, advice and support to all members of the family and the children themselves as they start to live more independent lives. We also offer bereavement support if a child sadly dies. At Little Hearts Matter we believe half a heart does not mean half a life. Please help us to help them.
