




I am so excited I am a big brother. Isla was born yesterday.






I am so excited I am a big brother but a little bit scared because Isla has had her operation today and is in a special ward at the hospital. PICU.

Here is the picture of Isla in her new bed. She has lots of plastic lines and a tube in her mouth.




Daddy says that is to help her breath as she gets better from the operation. Mummy and Daddy are with her in the hospital.

I feel so grown up.




We took her a new toy rattle and Mummy and Daddy some nice food. They have a kitchen at the hospital hotel so they can cook supper.
